USApple's NextGen Fellowship is an elite program that provides up-and-coming leaders with tools they need to achieve success in the apple industry.

The program has been broadening horizons for more than 10 years, providing young apple leaders with unique networking opportunities, professional development, a oneon-one mentorship program, hands-on experience with legislative and regulatory issues, team-building with peers, and much more.

What is Expected

NextGen Fellows are expected to be prepared, on-time, and professional throughout each session. They are expected to actively participate virtually (each month) and in-person (3 times a year). Fellows each film a video for USApple's #FreshPicks series, are expected to be active on USApple's social media, and must work together on their class project, outside of monthly virtual sessions. They are expected to take time to meet with their mentors and to work on a few professional development assignments.

Tuition

USApple covers hotels, meals, local transportation, and all programming registration and activities, which averages about \$6,000 per participant. Participants are responsible for their own airfare and travel (baggage, airport parking, taxi to airport, etc).

Eligibility

Emerging apple leaders who are at the start of their career through age 35 are eligible to participate.
