
Bearing acreage for U.S. apple orchards is **DOWN 10%** in the **last 20 years**.

U.S. Apple Acreage: Bearing Age




U.S. Apple Acreage: 2022 Levels

Bearing Age Acres: Top 10






U.S. Apple Acreage: 5-Year Growth





U.S. Apple Acreage: 5-Year Decline






U.S. Apple Acreage: Bearing Age / Non-Bearing Age






U.S. Fresh Apple Utilization / Acreage "Re-Fresh"





U.S. Apple Yield: Top 7 Apple States






U.S. Fresh Apple Packouts






U.S. Apple Production: Total 2023/24





U.S. Apple Production: Total 2023/24






U.S. Apple Prices: CPI






U.S. Apple Prices: Shipping-Point









U.S. Fresh Apple Exports*











U.S. Apple Production: USDA 2024/25 (F)



U.S. Apple Production: USDA 2024/25 (F)










